

[Certificate of making Decree Nisi Absolute (Divorce)]

and *Kathleen Lillian Waddell.* Respondent

and *C. Peter. Court.* Co-Respondent

Referring to the decree made in this Cause

on the *28th* day of *January* 1958.

whereby it was decreed that the Marriage had and solemnized on

the *20th* day of *May* 1944.

at *Quorn Parish Church in the County of Leicester*

between *Wardlaw Walter Waddell*

the Petitioner and *Kathleen Lillian Waddell.*

then Blunt spinster

the Respondent be dissolved by reason that the Respondent had

been guilty of adultery with C. Peter.

Court the Co Respondent.

unless sufficient cause be shown to the Court within three months from the making thereof why the said Decree should not be made absolute and no such cause having been shown, it is hereby certified that the said Decree was on this *29th* day of *May* 1958 made final and absolute and that the said Marriage was thereby dissolved.

Note: CHILDREN. If there are children of the marriage, either parent may request the Passport Office (Clive House, Petty France, London, S.W.1) not to issue a passport allowing them to go abroad without his or her knowledge.
