It is worth while considering for a moment what foundation there is for the grumbling we have had about the raising of the fees in the above-mentioned schools. The grumbling has not been very loud or deep, but it has found a certain amount of public expressions, and is deserving of a certain amount of consideration. The facts of the case are these:—The Board Schools were formed in two divisions—a higher and a lower grade—in the former of which were included Maras Street, Bellewille Place, Globe, and St Andrew's Square Schools, whilst the latter included Sir Michael Street, Shaw Street, Cara-furdbourn, Vennel, and Charity Schools. The fees in the latter division began at 4d and rose to 1s 4d a-month by stages of 2d for each standard. Those in the former began at 8d and rose to 2s a-month by stages of 2d up to 1s 4d, and thense from 1s 4d to 2s. In course of time the School Board found that its expenses were so great that if something were not done in the way of raising funds, it would require to put another 1d on the rate. Morroover, they discovered that the Mearns Street, Bellewille Place, and Glebe Schools were being utilised by parents who were perfectly well able to pay a higher fee for their children than they were paying then.
